Introduction to acrylic paint.

Book Cover Design: Use thumb impressions creatively, Focus on neatness and imagination

November – December

Animal Drawing Practice: Cat, Dog, Fish

Emphasis on using crayons for finishing

Art Integration: Drawing characters from stories, Simple Diwali craft

January – February

Revision & Creative Freedom: Freehand drawing: Any festival or nature

Preparation for Final Assessment: Holi/Morning View Drawing, Paper Folding Figures, Thumb Painted Book Cover, Cat Drawing
